The Orange County Sheriff's Office is requesting \$139,857.90 from the FY 2016 Law Enforcement Trust Fund for the following purpose:

Sheriff's Equipment:

Two Quick Response Bomb Technician X-Ray Systems - \$139,857.90. These funds will be used to purchase an Open Vision Real Time X-Ray unit and a NOVO Portable Tactical X-Ray unit to enhance the abilities of bomb technicians to quickly identify suspect explosive and hazardous devices in real time. These two units working together are able to clear suspicious items quickly during large events and large scale incidents.

ACTION REQUESTED: Approval for the Orange County Sheriff's Office to spend \$139,857.90 from the FY 2016 Law Enforcement Trust Fund for the purchase of two Quick Response Bomb Technician X-Ray Systems.

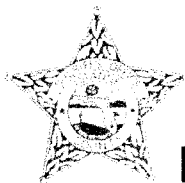


