American Recycling Group (Solid Waste Materials Recovery
Facility) Permit Transfer; District 2

The Environmental Protection Division has received a request to transfer solid waste management facility Permit No. SW-192228-MRF-10/1511, for an existing Materials Recovery Facility (MRF), from American Recycling Group, LLC, to Russo Waste Services, Inc. Both companies are State of Florida registered corporations and concur with the request. The subject property is located at 320 Enterprise Street, approximately 750 feet west of Maguire Road, within the limits of the City of Ocoee. Orange County Code Section 32-214(i) requires that permits may be transferred only upon approval of the Board of County Commissioners (BCC).

On September 22, 2015, the BCC approved renewal of this solid waste management facility permit. This facility is approved by Orange County to receive and process Class III solid waste, including construction and demolition debris. Class III waste does not include putrescible household (Class I) waste. Recyclable materials are separated out and residual waste is sent for offsite disposal. No disposal occurs at this site.

Russo Waste Services, Inc. is a land holdings company and has no compliance history in solid waste facility operations. Michael Russo has been the Operations Manager for American Recycling Group, LLC, and will continue as Operations Manager, as well as being Vice President of the new owner entity. The staff that conducts day-to-day operations at the facility will remain and they are in compliance with training requirements.

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American Recycling Group (Solid Waste Materials Recovery Facility) Permit Transfer

As required by Code, the facility currently has in place a financial assurance instrument to ensure proper closure of the site. This is a joint instrument shared with the Florida Department of Environmental Protection that administers it by agreement. Upon BCC approval of the transfer of permit, and in accordance with OCC Sec 32-314(e), the new permittee, Russo Waste Services Inc., will be required to provide approved financial assurance prior to permit issuance by EPD.

The current permit for this facility expires on November 8, 2020, and may request renewal prior to that expiration date.

Request to Transfer Solid Waste Management Permit

I, Marilyn Russo, as the authorized representative of Russo Waste Services Inc., a Florida corporation, am requesting that Orange County Permit No. SW-192228-MRF-10/1511, currently issued to American Recycling Group LLC, be transferred to Russo Waste Services Inc. (the corporation) under section 32-214(i) of the County Code. I do hereby acknowledge, by my signature below, that I have thoroughly reviewed all permit conditions and applicable ordinances, and that I am familiar with all field aspects of the site required to conduct a safe operation in compliance with the County's solid waste management ordinance. Russo Waste Services Inc. (the corporation) agrees to comply with the terms and conditions of solid waste management Permit No. SW-192228-MRF-10/1511 and the Orange County solid waste management ordinance and to operate the site in full accordance with all present and future requirements imposed by Orange County.

Furthermore, I acknowledge that the permit shall not be transferred to Russo Waste Services Inc. (the corporation) until: (1) the transfer has been approved by the Orange County Board of County Commissioners; (2) the County has approved all financial assurance documents required under the ordinance; and (3) all necessary and pre-approved financial assurance documents have been submitted to the Orange County Environmental Protection Officer.
