SUBJ: **Construction of Raised Crosswalk on Tanja King Boulevard**

Staff is requesting to install a raised crosswalk at two locations on Tanja King Boulevard at Guiana Plum Drive. Staff has been working with the neighborhood on developing traffic calming solutions and a raised crosswalk best fits the neighborhood due to the location of a community park and the width of the road. This will be the first raised crosswalk installed in unincorporated Orange County and will be considered a "pilot project." Staff will collect speed and volume data after the raised crosswalk is installed and compare it with previously collected data to measure its effectiveness on reducing speeds. If the raised crosswalk proves to be an effective tool, additional locations in the County may be considered.

The project is being funded by Commission District 4 and Public Works.

Action Requested: Approval to construct a raised crosswalk on Tanja King Boulevard. District 4.
