2.0 Transects

(e) Live/Work Units

- A. Elevated first floor.
- B. Porches and entries are detailed to the same level or at a higher level than the main body. Porch foundations, columns, railings, eaves, and ceiling treatment are all elements that define the style.
- C. Recessed front facade plane.
- D. Facade material variation.
- E. Multiple roof forms, such as gables and hips.
