# TOURIST DEVELOPMENT TAX COLLECTIONS ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA

ORLANDO, FLORIDA – Orange County Comptroller Phil Diamond announced today that tourist tax collections (resort tax) received by Orange County for the September 2018 TDT collection month were \$19,228,100. Tourist taxes are charged on short-term rentals, mostly hotels and motels.

Comptroller Diamond indicated that September 2018 collections were 1.0% higher than September 2017. "We did not have a big jump in numbers in September but we closed our fiscal year with over \$276 million of collections, an increase of more than 8% for the whole year. I hope that the new fiscal year will bring great results," stated Diamond.


