TOURIST DEVELOPMENT TAX COLLECTIONS ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA

ORLANDO, FLORIDA – Orange County Comptroller Phil Diamond announced today that tourist tax collections (resort tax) received by Orange County for the October 2018 TDT collection month were \$23,659,100. Tourist taxes are charged on short-term rentals, mostly hotels and motels.

Comptroller Diamond indicated that October 2018 collections were 7.4% higher than October 2017. "This is a great start to our new TDT year. I hope that the rest of the year will continue to be as strong as October," stated Diamond.
