## TOURIST DEVELOPMENT TAX COLLECTIONS ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA

ORLANDO, FLORIDA – Orange County Comptroller Phil Diamond announced today that tourist tax collections (resort tax) received by Orange County for the November 2018 TDT collection month were \$23,484,300. Tourist taxes are charged on short-term rentals, mostly hotels and motels.

Comptroller Diamond indicated that November 2018 collections were 7.5% higher than November 2017. "The Thanksgiving season was very good for Orange County's tourism economy. Thanks to November, we have started our year with two straight months of seven percent TDT growth," stated Diamond.
