TOURIST DEVELOPMENT TAX COLLECTIONS ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA

ORLANDO, FLORIDA – Orange County Comptroller Phil Diamond announced today that tourist tax collections (resort tax) received by Orange County for the February 2019 TDT collection month were \$25,194,300. Tourist taxes are charged on short-term rentals, mostly hotels and motels.

Comptroller Diamond indicated that February 2019 collections were 5.6% higher than February 2018. "After January's decrease, it is good to see February's numbers turn positive again. Hopefully, we will see the TDT numbers continue to increase," stated Diamond.
