TOURIST DEVELOPMENT TAX COLLECTIONS ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA

ORLANDO, FLORIDA – Orange County Comptroller Phil Diamond announced today that tourist tax collections (resort tax) received by Orange County for the April 2019 TDT collection month were \$25,886,400. Tourist taxes are charged on short-term rentals, mostly hotels and motels.

Comptroller Diamond indicated that April 2019 collections were 6.2% higher than April 2018. "Easter and many school spring breaks occurred in April this year. So, it was good to see April TDT collections increase by more than 6% over last year," stated Diamond.
