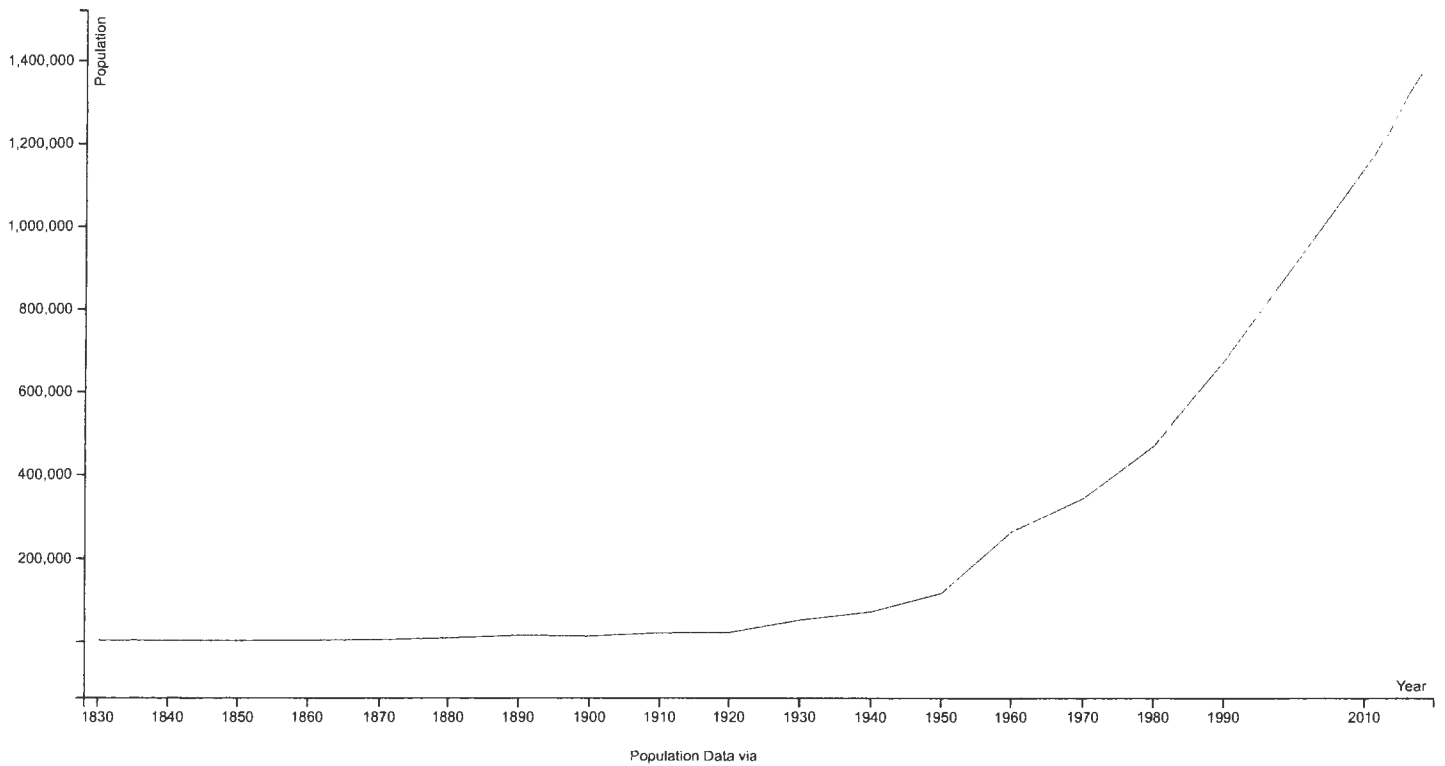

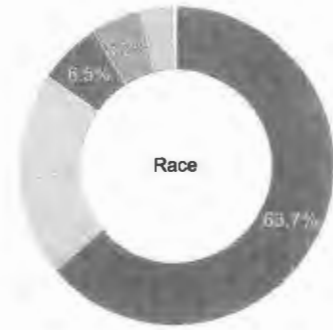

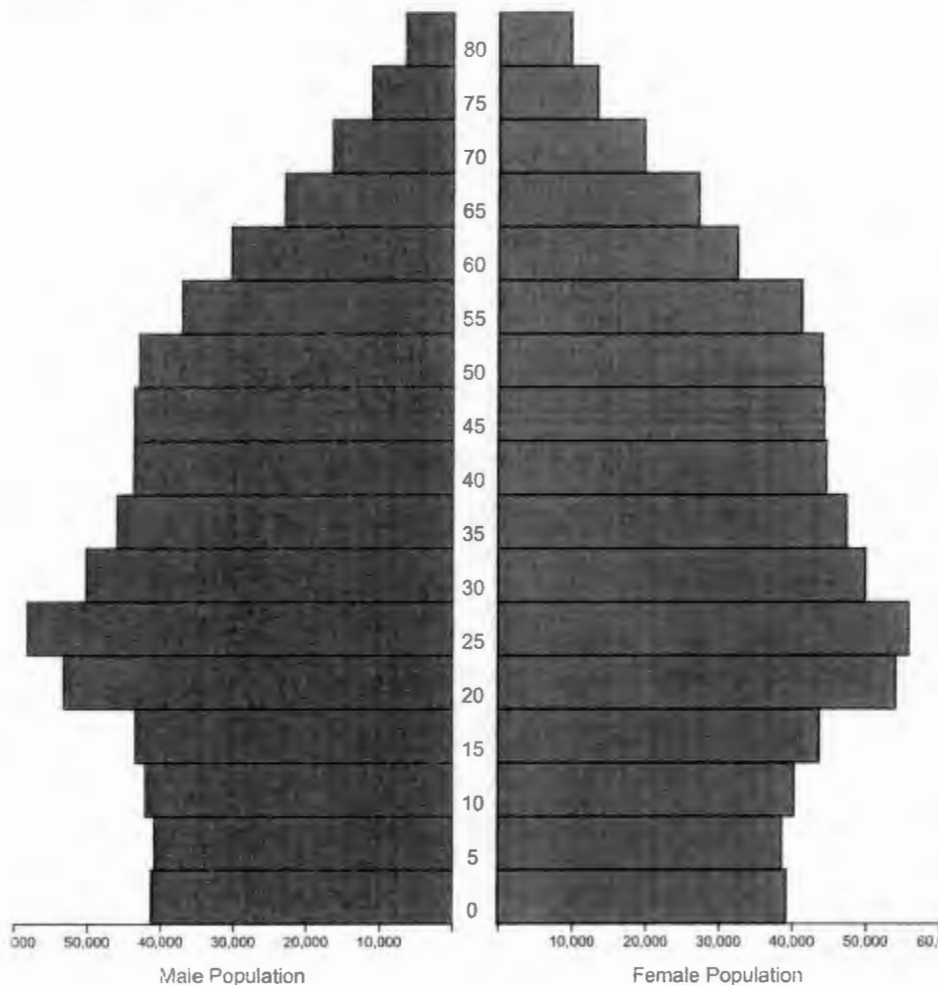

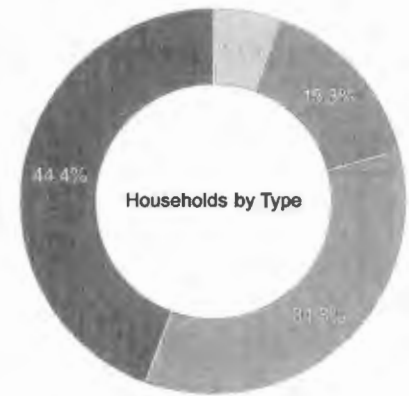

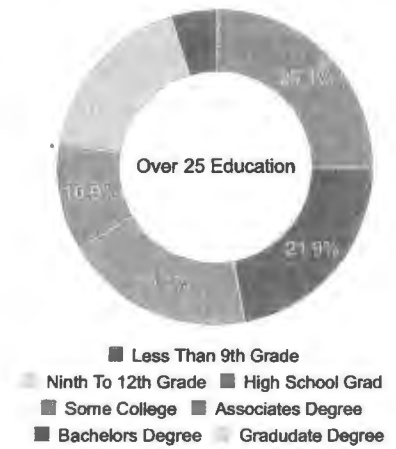
### Orange County, Florida Educational Attainment by Sex (over 25)

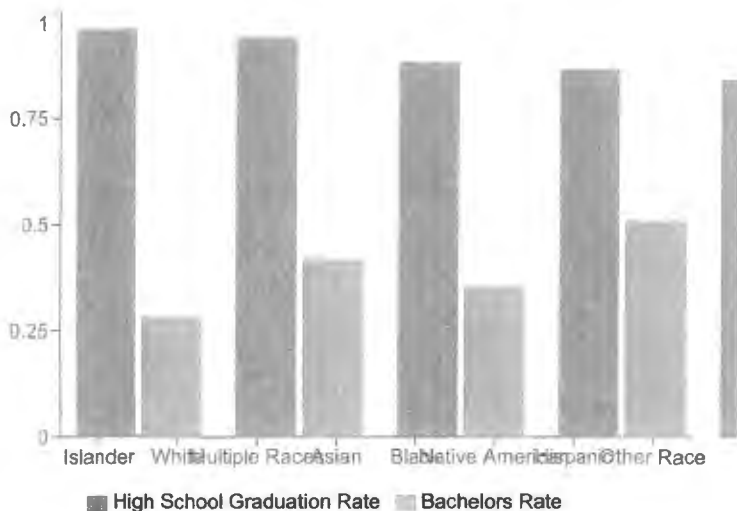


Orange County, Florida Educational Attainment by Race

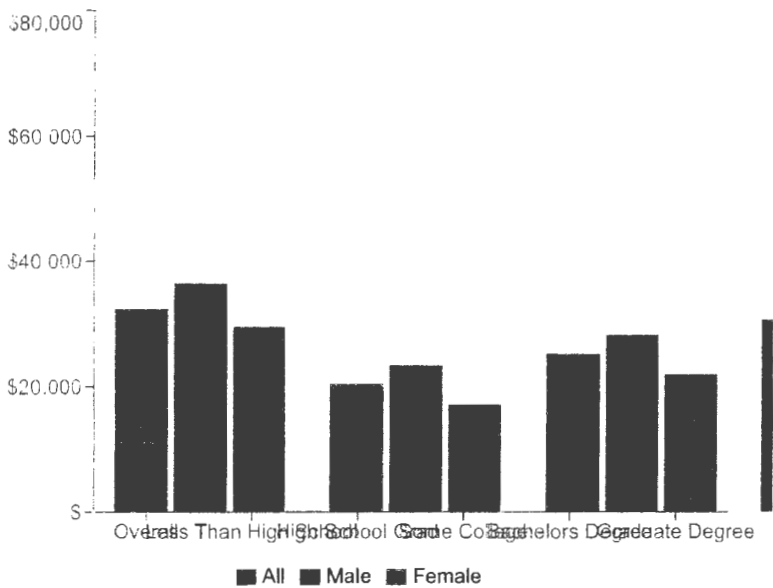

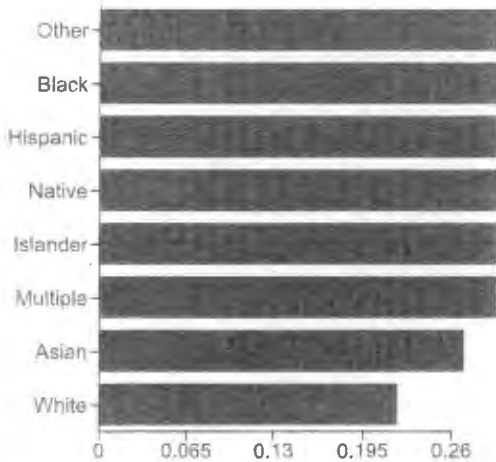

The race least likely to be in poverty in Orange County, Florida is White, with 10.19% below the poverty level.

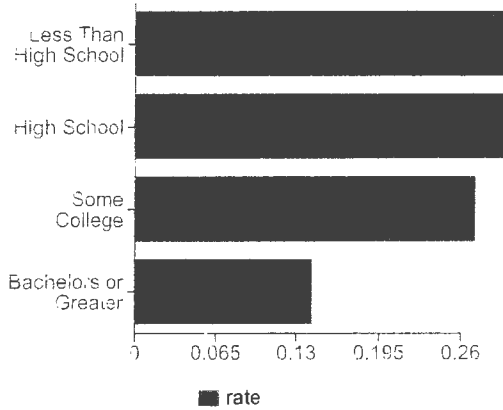

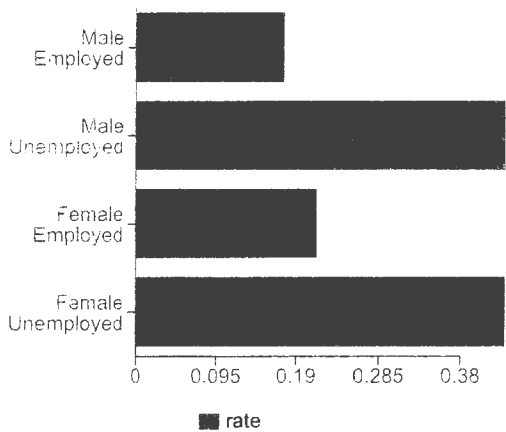

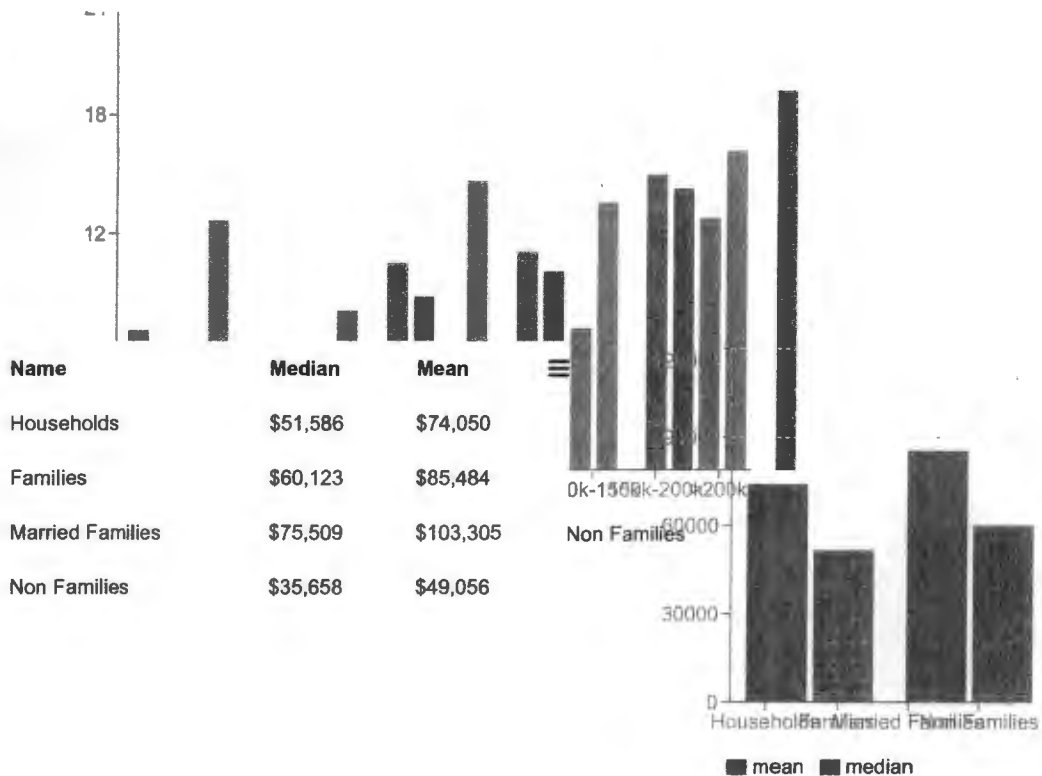

Orange County, Florida Income by Household Type





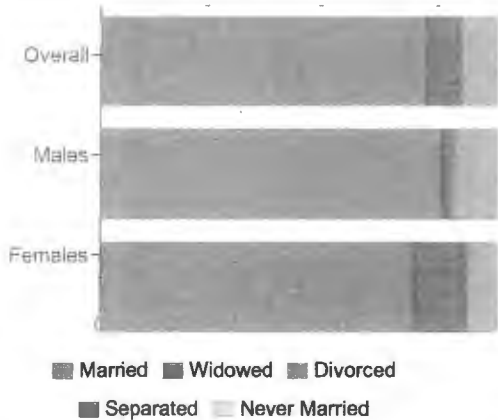

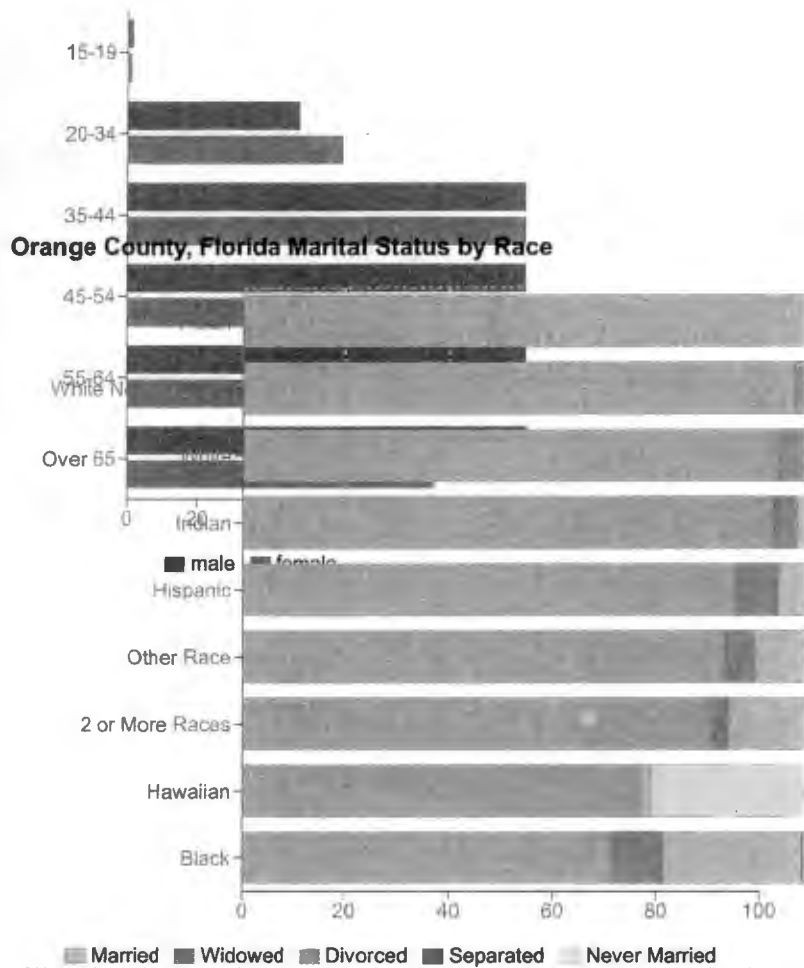

The age group where males are most likely to be married is Over 65, while the female age group most likely to be married is 45-54.

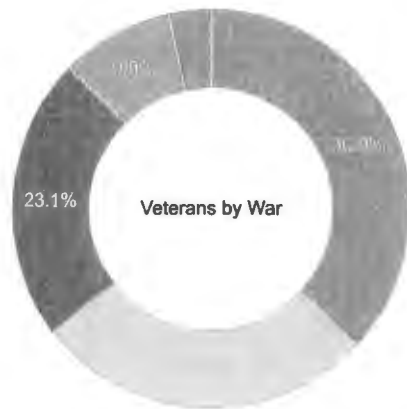

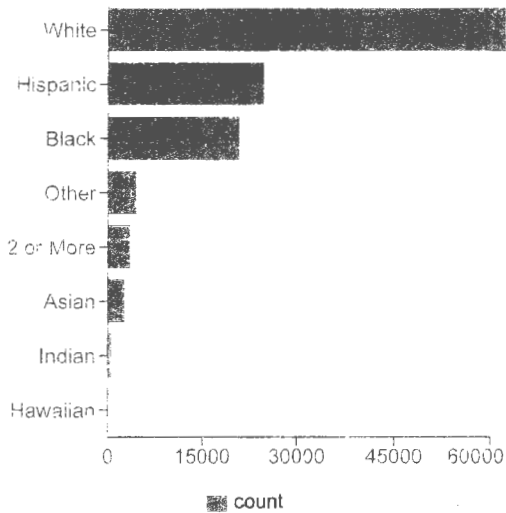

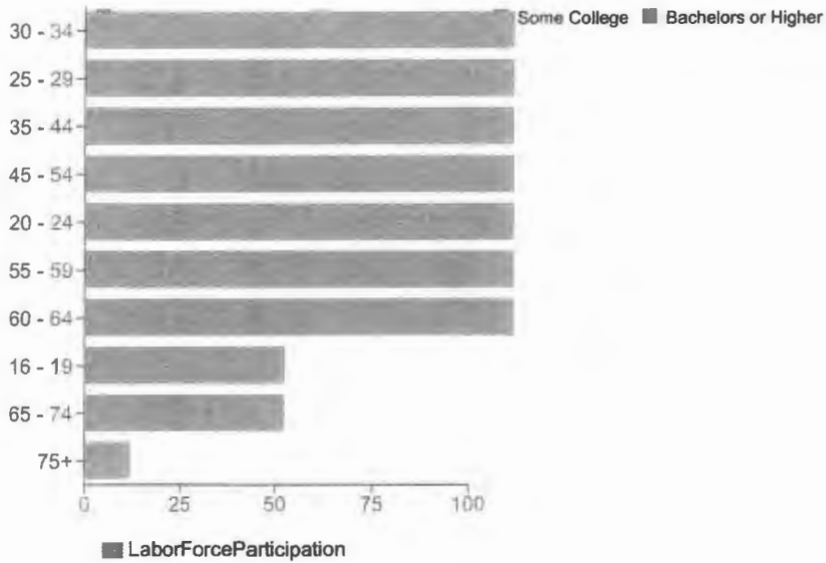

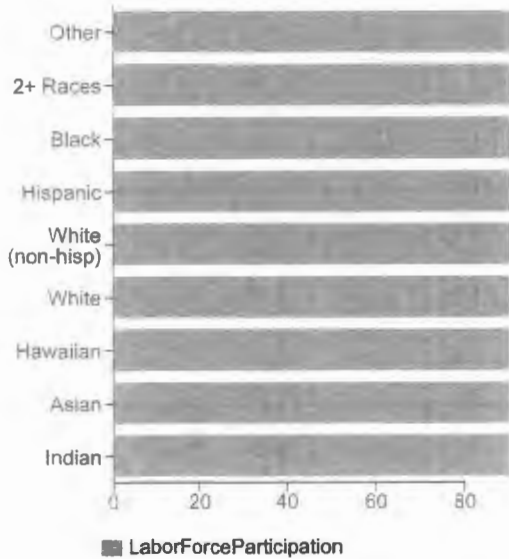

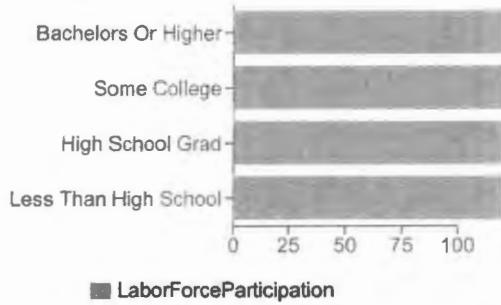
