**TOURIST DEVELOPMENT TAX COLLECTIONS
ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA**

ORLANDO, FLORIDA – Orange County Comptroller Phil Diamond announced today that tourist tax collections (resort tax) received by Orange County for the May 2019 TDT collection month were \$22,607,600. Tourist taxes are charged on short-term rentals, mostly hotels and motels.

Comptroller Diamond indicated that May 2019 collections were 4.7% higher than May 2018. “It is good to see another increase in the last full month of spring. I hope that this trend continues over the summer,” stated Diamond.
