**TOURIST DEVELOPMENT TAX COLLECTIONS
ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA**

ORLANDO, FLORIDA – Orange County Comptroller Phil Diamond announced today that tourist tax collections (resort tax) received by Orange County for the July 2019 TDT collection month were \$22,403,300. Tourist taxes are charged on short-term rentals, mostly hotels and motels.

Comptroller Diamond indicated that July 2019 collections were 3.1% higher than July 2018. “After a slight decrease in June, it is good to see our TDT numbers increase again in July. I hope that this trend continues,” stated Diamond.
