TOURIST DEVELOPMENT TAX COLLECTIONS ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA

ORLANDO, FLORIDA – Orange County Comptroller Phil Diamond announced today that tourist tax collections (resort tax) received by Orange County for the November 2019 TDT collection month were \$25,541,800. Tourist taxes are charged on short-term rentals, mostly hotels and motels.

Comptroller Diamond indicated that November 2019 collections were 8.7% higher than November 2018. "This news is a great start to 2020," stated Diamond.
