**TOURIST DEVELOPMENT TAX COLLECTIONS  
ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA**

ORLANDO, FLORIDA – Orange County Comptroller Phil Diamond announced today that tourist tax collections (resort tax) received by Orange County for the December 2019 TDT collection month were \$25,675,900. Tourist taxes are charged on short-term rentals, mostly hotels and motels.

Comptroller Diamond indicated that December 2019 collections were 9.0% higher than December 2018. “It was good to close out 2019 with strong tourist development tax growth in December. Popular college football bowl games and the opening of the second Star Wars: Galaxy’s Edge ride helped increase December tourism,” stated Diamond.
