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
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TOURIST DEVELOPMENT TAX COLLECTIONS ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA

ORLANDO, FLORIDA – Orange County Comptroller Phil Diamond announced today that Tourist Development Tax collections received by Orange County for the September 2021 TDT collection month were \$16,455,000. That is a 133.8% increase over September 2020.

Month-over-month, September collections were lower than August collections by \$7,100 and were also lower than September 2019 collections by \$1.3 million. In addition, September collections were the lowest in any pre-pandemic September since 2015. However, collections remain significantly above where they were at the beginning of the pandemic. Finally, on a fiscal year basis, FY2020-21 collections were higher than FY2019-20 by \$9.5 million, but lower than FY2018-19 by \$107.1 million. The chart below shows monthly TDT collections for the last three fiscal years. This year's collections were lower than any pre-pandemic year since FY2011-12.

On the TDT reserve side, the Renewal and Replacement Reserve increased for the month of September by \$7.1 million as shown in the attached "TDT Cash Reserve Summary." Note, there is a two month time lag between when TDT is collected and when it is remitted, received and recorded on the County's financial books. Therefore, September reserves reflect July TDT collections. On a cumulative basis, since the start of the pandemic, the County has used \$133.1 million of reserves to meet its TDT obligations. That has caused our undesignated "Other Authorized Uses" reserves to decrease from \$181.3 million to \$48.2 million during that time.

We will release the October TDT collections report in early December.

- 2. The County has committed to maintaining a reserve for property replacement equal to 4% of the Convention Center's gross physical plant and equipment-excluding construction in progress. This Renewal and Replacement Reserve component is currently fully funded at \$62,211,496.
