

## TOURIST DEVELOPMENT TAX COLLECTIONS ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA

ORLANDO, FLORIDA – Orange County Comptroller Phil Diamond announced today that Tourist Development Tax (TDT) collections received by Orange County for the April 2022 TDT collection month were \$34,665,500. That is a 103.1% increase over April 2021.

Month-over-month, April collections were lower than March collections by \$3.9 million and were higher than April 2020 collections by \$33.9 million. Notably, in April 2020, TDT collections plummeted by 97% to a record low level not seen since the 1980s. Two years later, in April 2022, TDT collections were the highest April collections on record and the second highest collections ever! The chart below shows monthly TDT collections for the current fiscal year and the previous two fiscal years.

Hotel occupancy was 79.4% in April 2022, only slightly below 80.9% in April 2019, and the average daily rate (ADR) was \$169 (Source: Visit Orlando). On the TDT reserve side, there was a \$8.6 million increase in the Renewal and Replacement Reserve in April as shown in the attached "TDT Cash Reserve Summary". On a cumulative basis, since the start of the pandemic, the County has used \$109.6 million of reserves to meet its TDT obligations. That has caused our undesignated "Other Authorized Uses" reserves to decrease from \$181.3 million to \$71.7 million during that time.

We will release the May TDT collections report in early July.

- 1. Debt service reserves are restricted for debt service only and equal the maximum annual debt service payment.
- 2. The County has committed to maintaining a reserve for property replacement equal to 4% of the Convention Center's gross physical plant and equipment-excluding construction in progress. This Renewal and Replacement Reserve component is currently fully funded at \$63,161,149.
